

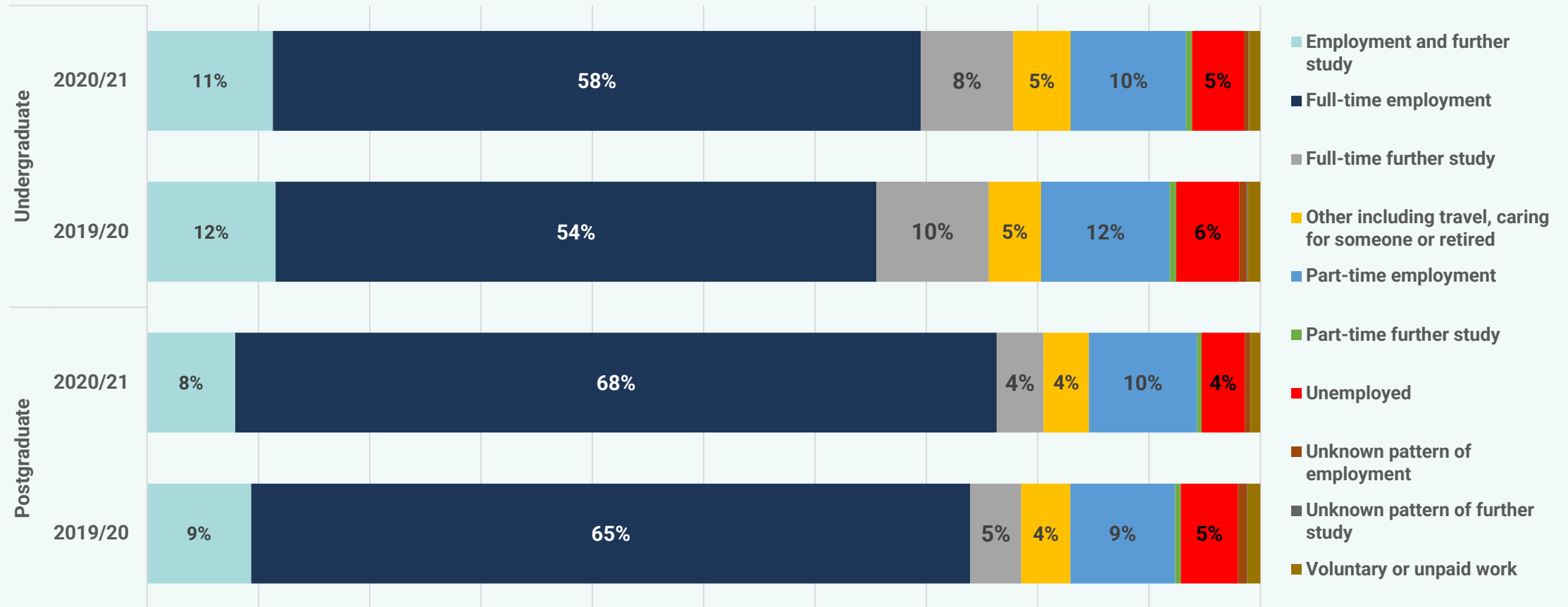

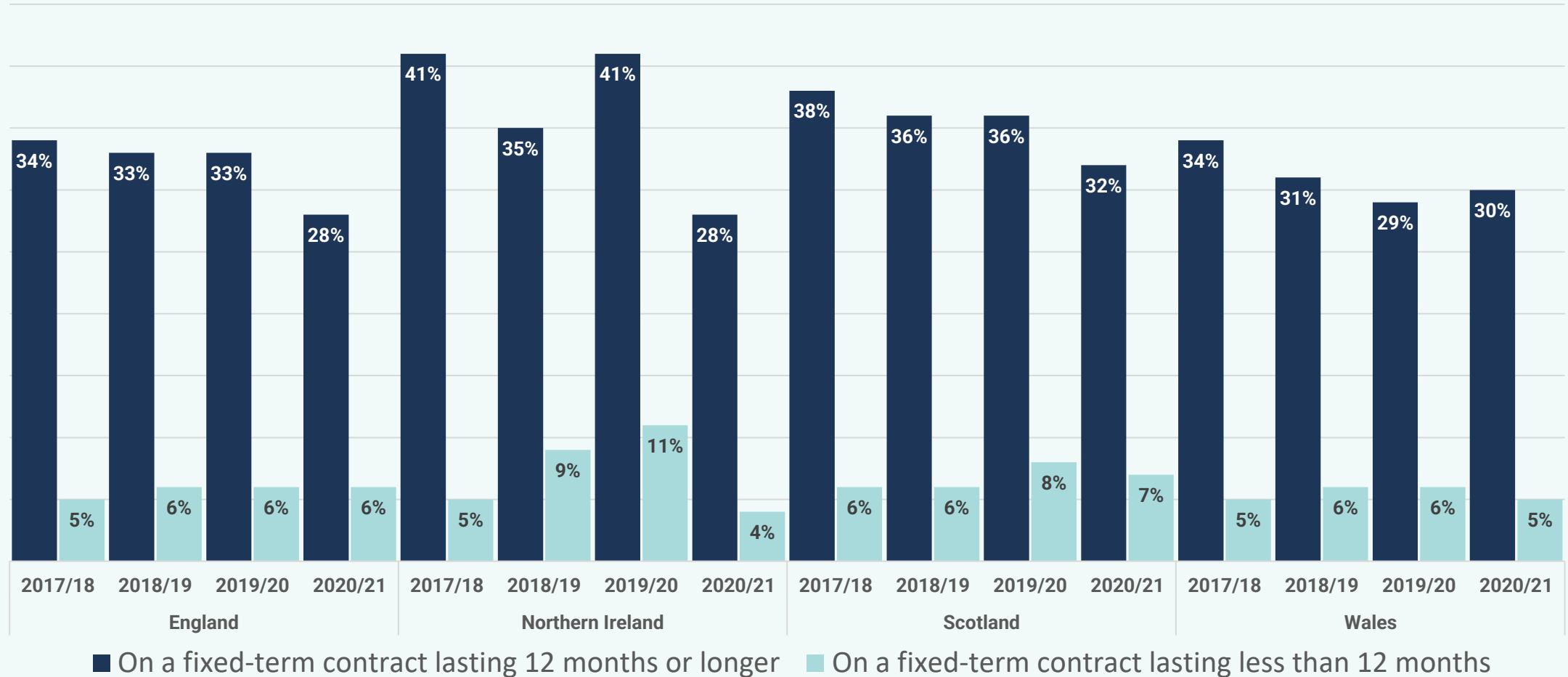
About the Graduate Outcomes Survey

The Graduate Outcomes survey is the biggest annual social survey in the UK and captures the perspectives and current status of graduates. All graduates who completed a higher education course in the UK after August 2017 are asked to take part in the survey 15 months after they finish their studies.

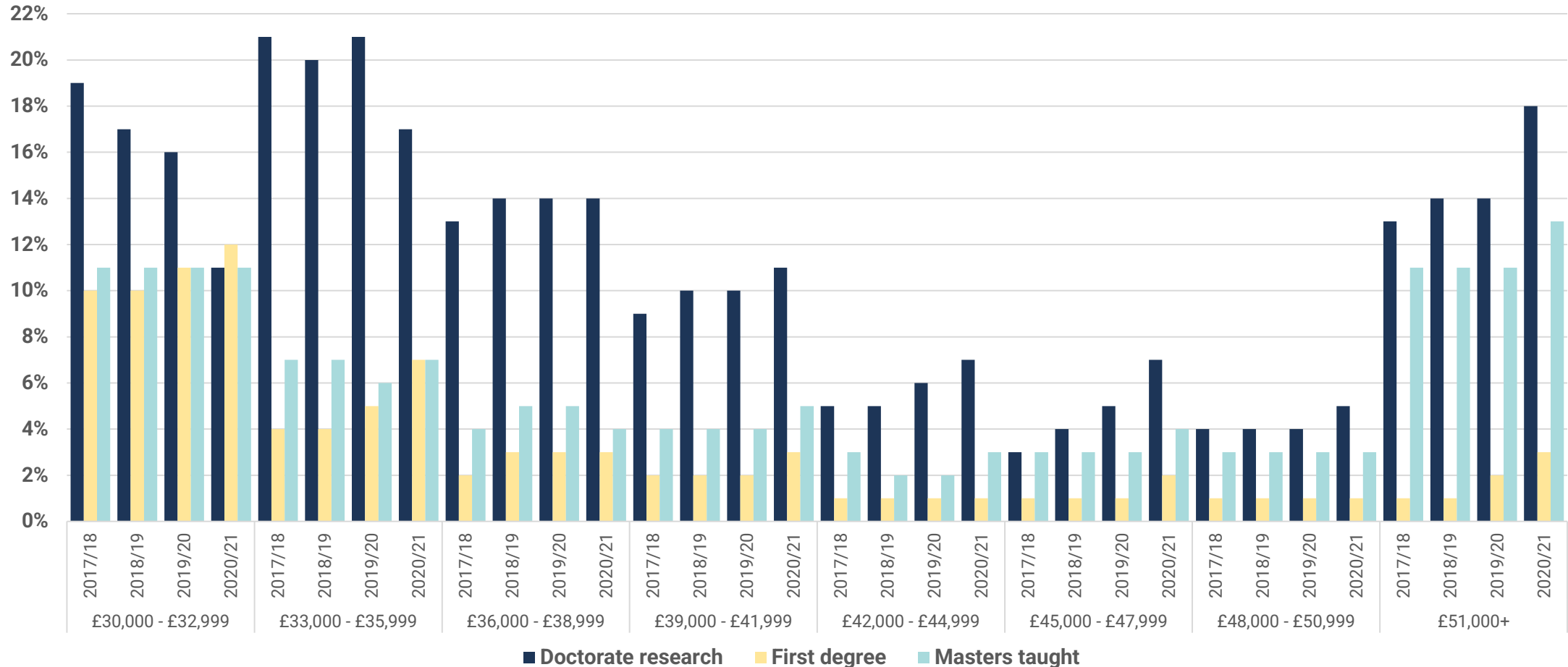
This chart shows the activities of graduates (excluding 'non-responders').



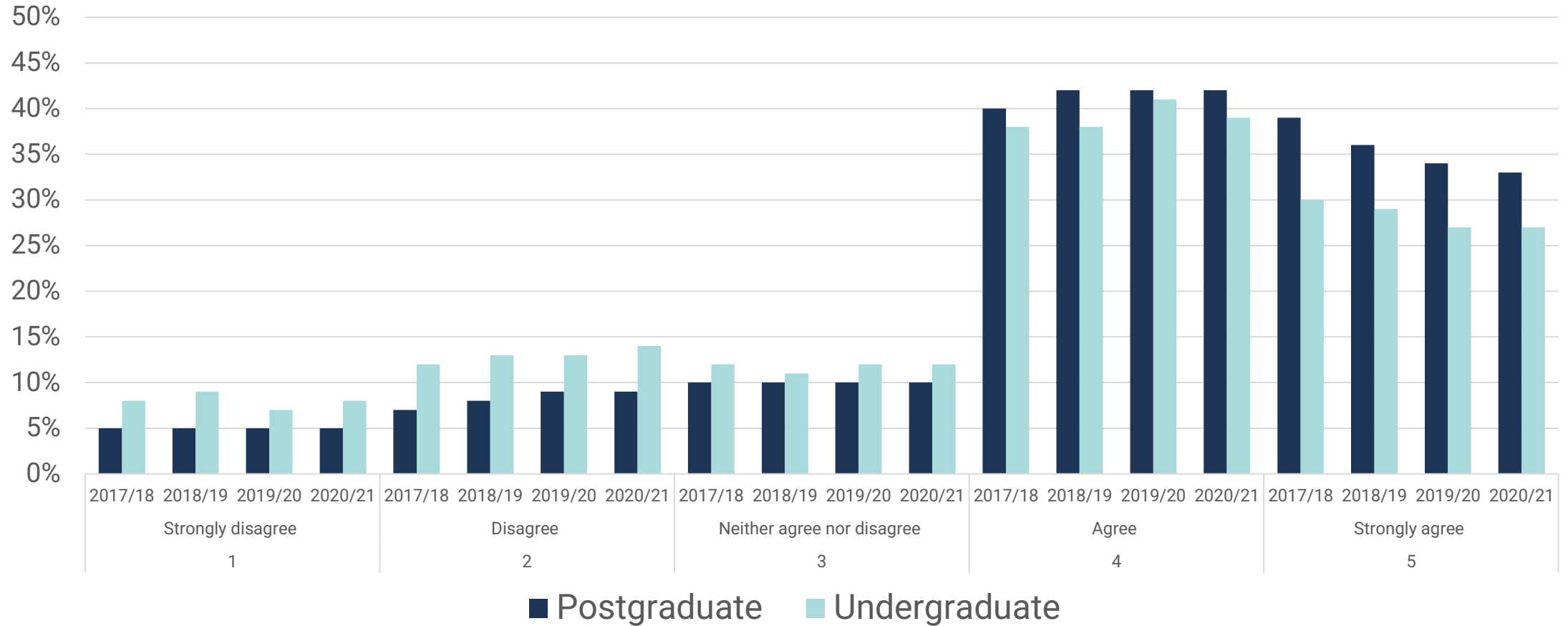
This chart shows the percentage of graduates with research degrees on fixed term contracts by country of HE Provider. It shows a slight decrease in the prevalence of fixed term contracts lasting 12 months or longer among graduates from all HE providers (with a recent up-tick in the use of these contracts among graduates from Welsh HE Providers, but still lower than 2017/18 levels).
